

CAPE TOWN - ORKCA DIRECTIONS

Prepare yourself for quite a long drive (approximately 900km), please remember your passport and enjoy the beautiful scenery and change in landscape over the distance.

- Leave Cape Town on the N7 head to Vioolsdrif / Noordoewer. From Cape Town you will drive through Malmesbury, Moorreesburg, Piketberg, Citrusdal, Clanwilliam, Klawer, Vanrhynsdorp, Nuwerus, Bitterfontein, Garies, Kamieskroon, Springbok, Steinkopf followed by Vioolsdrif and Noordoewer.
- Cross border into Namibia which normally takes 1 hour.
- Remember to fill up on fuel in Noordoewer, located just after the border (Noordoewer is the last place with good South African cellphone service).
- Leave Noordoewer on the B1 drive for approximately 50km and take a right on to the D213 heading to Warmbad. From here on up till the headquarters all roads will be gravel roads.
- Drive for another 35km you will reach a T-junction take a left onto the D208.
- Drive on the D208 for another 17km at the next junction turn right onto the D210, which leads directly to Warmbad after 25km.
- Once in Warmbad continue on the D210 until you cross the large concrete river bridge, approximately 300m after the bridge, there will be an old garage on your left, take a right at this point onto the D206.
- Warmbad is the last location with good Namibian cellphone service.
- Continue on the D206 for 35km until you see the ORKCA sign on your right along with NTI mine sign in blue and a Kudu horns sign reading 'Kum Kum', take a right at this point.
- Continue for 10km on this road until you reach a gate on the left and kudu horn sign saying 'Kum Kum', take a left here onto the farm road.
- Continue along the farm road through 3 gates (normally they are open) until you reach a few rundown buildings, pass them and shortly after you will reach a large gate with an ORKCA sign on. Go through gate (remember to close gate please) keep going until you reach the headquarters.



GENERAL DETAILS

- All the houses on the farm are fully furnished and equipped with all the necessary utensils.
- Access to Kum Kum's solar system for charging devices
- Bring relevant adaptors (type C & D)
- Wi-Fi is available at the main house and cottage but there is no mobile network on the reserve.
- Due to limited data availability, it is recommended to use data sparingly so that everyone can stay connected.



Kindly follow these guidelines:

- Pause all background updates on your devices during your stay.
- Utilize WhatsApp voice calls instead of video calls whenever possible.
- Reduce the amount of social media usage, such as YouTube, Instagram, etc.
