

WINDHOEK - ORKCA DIRECTIONS

Directions driving from Windhoek to Kum Kum Head Quarters;

Prepare yourself for quite a long drive (approximately **840km**).

Enjoy the beautiful scenery and the changing landscapes along the way. The roads are long but usually have little traffic. Take regular breaks and bring sunglasses for the glare.

- Leave Hosea Kutako International Airport, once outside the premises, take a right onto the **B6** and head towards Windhoek (**40km**). Beware of the speed cameras.
- As you enter Windhoek, take a left onto Jan Jonker Street, and at the intersection, take a left onto Robert Mugabe Avenue, keep on this road. You will cross two roundabouts, follow the road until you reach the newly constructed Eastern Bypass, take a right here onto the Rehobother Road/**B1**. At the next intersection, take a left and keep on the Rehobother Road/**B1**.
- Follow the **B1** directly south. You will pass through Rehoboth (a good place to refuel), Kalkrand, Mariental, Tses and Keetmanshoop (a good place to refuel).
- As you leave Keetmanshoop, you will reach a roundabout, take the first exit to the left and stay on the **B1** heading to Grunau.
- As you enter Grunau take the first left onto the **B3** heading to Karasburg.
- As you enter Karasburg (refuel again, as this is the last fuel station). Follow the **B3** around the bend to the left. Continue until you see the Bank Windhoek building on your right. Take a right just after the Bank Windhoek onto the **M21** that changes into the **C21**, keep on this road until you reach Warmbad.
- Once you enter Warmbad the road forks, take a left until you reach a **T junction**, take a left again onto the **D206** leaving Warmbad. You will see the old German styled police station on your left as you exit Warmbad.
- Follow the **D206** for **35km** until you see an ORKCA sign on your right, along with an **NTI** mine sign in blue and a Kudu horns sign indicating Kum Kum. Take a right turn here.
- Drive for another **10km** on this road until you reach a gate on the left, marked with a kudu horn sign saying Kum Kum. Take a left here onto the farm road, proceed along the farm road, passing through three gates (which are usually open) until you reach a few rundown buildings. Continue past them, and shortly after, you will reach a large gate with an ORKCA sign. Go through the gate (remember to close it) and keep going until you reach the headquarters.



GENERAL DETAILS

- All the houses on the farm are fully furnished and equipped with all the necessary utensils.
- Access to Kum Kum's solar system for charging devices
 - Bring relevant adaptors (type C & D)
- Wi-Fi is available at the main house and cottage but there is no mobile network on the reserve.
- Due to limited data availability, it is recommended to use data sparingly so that everyone can stay connected.



Kindly follow these guidelines:

- Pause all background updates on your devices during your stay.
- Utilize WhatsApp voice calls instead of video calls whenever possible.
- Reduce the amount of social media usage, such as YouTube, Instagram, etc.
